**OTHER POINTS TO CONSIDER:**

Look at the Street Listing to see if street is an accepted city street	YES	NO

**STEPS THAT ARE FOLLOWED:**

Foreman will go to site, measure the tree to determine if the tree is within city layout.

If the tree is not within the layout, a letter will be sent to you stating that the tree is on private property. If the tree is near, or in electrical wires, the TMLP should be contacted to request the removal/trim. We do not determine if the TMLP will remove this tree.

If the Foreman and Tree Warden is unable to determine the street layout, due to a variable width of the street, then the tree request will be referred to the City Engineer.

Once the referral has been made to the city Engineer, he will actually go out to the site to look at the tree, measure street layout, and refer to city street layout maps to determine if the tree is actually in the right of way
