

SECTION 1. The second sentence of Section 8-27, Chapter 8, of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Taunton, as appearing, is hereby amended by striking the phrase "seven hundred dollars (\$700)" and replacing same with "three hundred dollars (\$300)"

1. Delete the words “corn mission” and replace with “commission”.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.

AN ORDINANCE

Chapter 12

Licenses and Miscellaneous Business Regulations

Sec. 12-4

Be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the City of Taunton as follows:

SECTION 1. That the following section 12-4 be inserted in the Revised Ordinances of the City of Taunton, following section 12-3.

Section 12-4: Criminal History Check Authorization

(a) *Applicant's Submission to Fingerprinting by the Police Department.* Any applicant for a license to engage in any of the following occupational activities with the City of Taunton shall submit a full set of fingerprints taken by the Taunton Police Department within ten (10) days of the date of the application for a license for the purpose of conducting a state and national criminal record background check to determine the suitability of the application for the license:

- i. Hawker and Peddler
- ii. Liquor Licensee
- iii. Manager or alternate manager of a Liquor Licensee
- iv. Solicitors and Canvassers

- v. Dealers in Junk, Second-Hand Articles and Antiques
- vi. Second-Hand Motor Vehicle Dealer
- vii. Hackney Carriage Operator
- viii. Ice Cream Truck Vendor
- ix. Door to door solicitors

- (b) *Notice to applicant.* At the time of fingerprinting, the Police Department must notify each individual who is fingerprinted that his or her fingerprints will be used to check such individual's national and state criminal history records.
- (c) *Police Department Processing of Criminal Record Background Checks.* The Police Department shall transmit fingerprints it has obtained pursuant to this ordinance to the Identification Section of the Massachusetts State Police, the Massachusetts Department of Criminal Information Services and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) as may be necessary for the purpose of conducting fingerprint based state and national criminal records background checks of license applicants specified in section (a) of this ordinance. The Police Department is authorized to receive and utilize state and FBI records in connection with such background checks, consistent with this ordinance. The state and FBI criminal history will not be disseminated to unauthorized entities.
- (d) *Applicant notification of results.* The Police Department shall provide the applicant with a copy of the results of his or her fingerprint based criminal record background check and provide the applicant the opportunity to complete, or challenge the accuracy of, the information contained in said record, including in the FBI identification record. The Police Department must also supply applicants with information regarding the procedures for obtaining a change, correction or updating a criminal record, including a copy of 28 CFR Part 16.34 pertaining to FBI identification records.
- (e) *Police communication of results to licensing authority.* The Police Department shall communicate the results of fingerprint based criminal record background checks to the applicable licensing authority within the City, but only after complying with subsection (d) of this ordinance. The Police Department shall in addition render to the licensing authority its evaluation of the applicant's suitability for the proposed occupational activity based upon the results of the criminal records background check and any other relevant information known to it. In rendering its evaluation, the Police Department shall consider all applicable laws, regulations and City policies bearing on an applicant's suitability. The Police Department shall indicate where the applicant has been convicted of, or is under pending indictment for, a crime that bears upon his or her suitability, or any felony, or any misdemeanor that involved force or the threat of force, controlled substance or a sex related offense.

(f) *Reliance on results.* Licensing authorities of the City shall utilize the results of the fingerprint based criminal record background checks for the sole purpose of determining the suitability of the applicant for the proposed occupational activity which is the subject of the license applications specified in section (a), above. A City licensing authority may deny an application for a license on the basis of the results of a fingerprint based criminal record background check if it determines that the results of the check render the subject unsuitable for the proposed occupational activity. The licensing authority shall consider all applicable laws, regulations and City policies bearing on an applicant's suitability in making this determination. The licensing authority shall not deny a licensed based on information in a criminal record unless the applicant has been afforded a reasonable time to correct or complete the record or has declined to do so.

(g) *Compliance with law.* Implementation of this ordinance and the conduct of fingerprint based criminal background checks by the City shall be in accordance with all applicable laws. The Chief of Police is authorized to promulgate regulations for the implementation of this ordinance. The City shall not disseminate criminal record information received to unauthorized persons or entities.

(h) *Fees.* The fee charged by the Police Department for the purpose of conducting fingerprint based criminal record background checks shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per application processed. A portion of the fee, as specified in G.L. c. 6, §172B 1/2, shall be deposited into the Firearms Fingerprint Identify Verification Trust Fund, and the remainder of the fee may be retained by the City for costs associated with the administration of the fingerprinting system.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.

The Engineering Department reviewed the plan and report for the conversion of 54 Longmeadow Road into multi-family residential use, and has the following comments:

1. Beyond some proposed plantings for screening, it doesn't appear as though any exterior work is proposed, is this true?
 - a. Consider pavement rehab of the existing driveway and parking area.
 - b. Reconstruct sidewalk with accessible driveway ramps.
2. City records indicate the sewer lateral of 6" PVC at the street, but only 4" at the building line. Will this be adequate?
3. What are the requirements for accessibility to the building? Currently the front walkway is *not* accessible.
4. Will the main entrance be from the rear? This needs to be shown.
5. When the main entrance is identified, HP parking spots must be located.
6. Although the curb cuts are adequate for two-way travel, consider a one way in and one way out pair. (Northerly curb cut in, southerly curb cut out.) This will reduce the chance of conflict at the front entrance.

Central Business District

7.3 OFF-STREET PARKING

7.3.1 PARKING AND LOADING REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Parking Requirements in all districts except for Central Business District

Must be provided on-site

Residential Units: 2 spaces per unit

Assisted Living: 1 space per unit

Retail: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 300 square feet over 600 square feet gross floor area

Office: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 500 square feet over 1,000 square feet gross floor area

Industrial uses: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 850 square feet over 1,700 square feet gross floor area

Restaurants, hotel restaurant, cafeteria, hall, club, theater, bowling alley or other place of assembly:

Spaces equal in number to not less than half the seating capacity of each such establishment.

Miscellaneous Uses: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 400 square feet over 800 square feet gross floor area

Minimum Parking Requirements in Central Business District

Residential Units: 1 spaces per unit

Assisted Living: 1 space per unit

Retail: 1 space per 300 square feet over 2,500 square feet gross floor area

Office: 1 space per 300 square feet over 1,000 square feet gross floor area

Industrial uses: minimum 3 spaces, plus 1 space per 850 square feet over 1,700 square feet gross floor area

Restaurants, hotel restaurant, cafeteria, hall, club, theater, bowling alley or other place of assembly: Spaces equal in number to not less than one fourth the seating capacity of each such establishment.

Miscellaneous Uses: 1 space per 400 square feet over 800 square feet gross floor area

Parking Space size: 9 feet by 18 feet, exclusive of driveways

Minimum Aisle Width: The aisle width between parking spaces shall not be less than 22 feet where parking is located on both sides of the aisle.

Special Provisions

An off-street parking area containing one hundred and sixty two (162) square feet of paved surface exclusive of driveways, shall be provided for each motor vehicle stored overnight or longer by an occupant of the premises.

Parking and loading areas are to be graded, subsurfaced, with a non-dusting material, drained and suitably maintained to the extent necessary to avoid nuisance of dust, erosion, or any water flow onto streets or adjoining properties.

A parking area shall not be designed to interfere with loading or unloading zones, access driveways, or egress and ingress to the site.

No loading platform or receiving door shall be located in any front yard, or on the street side of any retail store or other commercial building except a gasoline filling station.

In the Central Business District, for buildings in existence in their current size and bulk as of January 1, 2016, off-street parking requirements may be satisfied if an off-street municipal parking lot exists within 500 feet of the proposed use.

In the Business District and Central Business District parking may be waived or reduced by the Special Permit or Site Plan Review Granting Authority.

In Industrial Districts the following areas may be excluded in figuring the gross floor area: hallways, lobbies, boiler rooms and other unoccupiable space which shall be determined by the Building Commissioner or City Planner.

Mobile Homes

Section 11.1.3.3 Density of Use

There shall be no more than six (6) mobile home units with accessories per acre, exclusive of park and access roads and the area to be set aside for the use of recreation, service, and other permanent facilities. There shall be at least as fifty (50) foot frontage on all mobile home lots.

The occupied area of a mobile home lot shall not exceed thirty-five (35%) percent of the lot area.

Mobile homes shall not be located closer than ten (10) feet to the nearest ~~mobile home lot line or park street~~; and no mobile home accessory building closer than five (5) feet to ~~that lot line or a park street~~. **In addition, mobile homes shall be located at least 15 feet from abutting mobile homes and mobile home accessory buildings shall be located at least 10 feet from abutting mobile homes.**

Each mobile home shall be located with at least a forty (40) foot set back from any park property boundary ~~abutting a public street or highway~~.

Special Flood Hazard Districts

13.8.1.11 New construction or substantial reconstruction on lots where a Special Flood Hazard District encroaches, shall show on the permit plan the limits of said flood zone along with its base flood elevation. Upon completion, an Elevation Certificate (FEMA Form 086-0-33, or latest version), properly completed, sealed and signed, must be submitted along with the as-built site plan, before a Certificate of Occupancy is issued.





Dear Council President Quinn and Councilors:

Please find herewith the final drafts of an intermunicipal agreement between Taunton and Lakeville ("Transfer Agreement") and associated Amendment Agreement, which will be used to effectuate the acquisition of the Lakeville Water Tower and Pump Station premises. In essence, as you may recall, in consideration of the conveyance, Taunton is taking the place of Lakeville as borrower on a loan from the Massachusetts Clean Water Trust, and reimbursing Lakeville back to FY2015. On July 7, 2015, the Committee of the Council as a Whole favorably considered the acquisition. At that time the Council voted to authorize the filing of special legislation to acquire the two parcels and the negotiation of a final draft of the intermunicipal agreement. The special legislation, Chapter 32 of the Acts of 2016, was approved by the Legislature on February 10, 2016. Mrs. Auger reports that the Council has appropriated the funds necessary to pay the costs of acquiring the premises and authorized the required borrowing. On June 9, 2016, the Trust is scheduled to meet, and presumably approve, the Amendment Agreement, subject to Taunton's approval. The closing is scheduled for June 30, 2016. I respectfully request therefore, that you approve these documents and authorize the conveyance at the June 14, 2016 meeting. A suggested motion is: (a) "authorize the Mayor and Treasurer/Collector to sign the Transfer Agreement and Amendment agreement, respectively, (b) approve the conveyance of the premises from Lakeville to Taunton, and (c) authorize the Mayor, Treasurer/Collector and Solicitor to take all reasonable actions necessary to effectuate the conveyance." Thank you for allowing our office to assist you in this matter.


