## **ORDERS, ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS**

### **Order for a first reading to be passed to a second reading**

Ordered That,

\$3,202,310.07 is appropriated to pay costs of acquiring the Lakeville Water Tower and Pump Station, including the payment of any and all costs incidental and related thereto, and that to meet this appropriation, \$435,839.96 shall be appropriated from available funds of the City; and the City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor, is authorized to borrow \$2,766,470.11 under and pursuant to Chapter 44, Section 8 and/or Chapter 29C of the General Laws, or pursuant to any other enabling authority, and to issue bonds or notes of the City therefor. Such borrowing shall be obtained through the facilities of the Massachusetts Clean Water Trust (the "Trust"), reflecting the assignment and assumption by the City of the outstanding debt of the Town of Lakeville originally issued to the Trust to pay costs of constructing this facility. In connection with the loan to be obtained through the Trust, the Mayor and City Treasurer are each authorized to execute an Amendment Agreement and/or Financing Agreement and Project Regulatory

Agreement, and any other documents in such forms as the Trust and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection shall require.

**Chapter 19**

**Sewer and Drains**

**Sec 19-19. Sewer Rates/Sewer user charges; late penalty.**

**SECTION 2.**

Two Tiered billing rates:

Step 2: \$6.76 per hcf for the incremental usage in excess of 30 hcf (quarterly bills); and 10 hcf (monthly bills), respectively.

For bills issued after July 1, 2017:

Step 1: \$2.35 per hcf for usage of 1 to 30 hcf (quarterly bills); and 1 to 10 hcf (monthly bills), respectively.

Step 2: \$8.37 per hcf for the incremental usage in excess of 30 hcf (quarterly bills); and 10 hcf (monthly bills), respectively.



Dear Mayor Hoye and Members of the City Council:

As you are aware, we have asked the Urban Land Institute (ULI) to assist the City of Taunton in identifying realistic market opportunities to attract private investment and business prospects in our downtown, given the existing market conditions, unique characteristics and competitive advantages of the downtown. Ultimately, ULI will craft a targeted marketing strategy plan which recommends concrete steps aimed at pursuing these opportunities and prospects. To this end, we have asked the ULI panel, consisting of experts in the fields of real estate development, finance, business, and urban planning, to address four specific questions centered on attracting private investment towards advancing our efforts towards revitalizing downtown. The four questions are as follows:

1. Based on the existing physical, demographic, and market conditions of downtown Taunton, what types of investments are most likely to take place and make the most sense for the City?
2. How can investments in the downtown best be attracted and are there measures the City can take to attract more investment?
3. What are the City's most important strengths and assets and how can those strengths and assets be incorporated into future redevelopment strategies?
4. Is the City's vision for downtown clear enough for future redevelopment efforts?

**The Urban Land Institute Technical Assistance Panel is scheduled to visit Taunton on Tuesday May 3<sup>rd</sup>. The panel will be in Taunton all day ending with a public presentation of their findings and recommendations to the City Council at 6:00 pm.**

The Office of Economic and Community Development is very excited about this opportunity for the City to work with the Urban Land Institute and believes this initiative will be an important catalyst to future downtown revitalization efforts.

I am questioning the current runway lengths and how they could possibly approve small jets taking off and landing in a safe manor.


Storage of Jet A fuel, the effects of exhaust to residents and children, effects to any leakage to our environment.
