Each prior loan order of the City that authorizes the borrowing of money to pay costs of capital projects is hereby supplemented to provide that, in accordance with Chapter 44, Section 20 of the General Laws, the premium received by the City upon the sale of any bonds or notes thereunder, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds or notes, may be applied to pay project costs and the amount authorized to be borrowed for each such project shall be reduced by the amount of any such premium so applied.

The City of Taunton appropriate the amount of **\$2,250,000** in addition to the \$2,500,000 previously appropriated, for the purpose of paying costs for roof, window, and door repairs/replacements at the Edmund Hatch Bennett Elementary School, 47 No. Walker St, Taunton, MA 02780, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto (the "Project"), which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program, and for which the City of Taunton may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the City of Taunton's Building Committee. To meet this appropriation, the Treasurer Collector with the approval of the Mayor is authorized to borrow said amount under Chapter 44 of the General Laws or any other enabling authority. The City of Taunton acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs the City of Taunton incurs in excess of any grant that may be approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the City of Taunton; provided that the borrowing authorized pursuant to this order shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the City of Taunton and the MSBA; that the Mayor is authorized to take any other action necessary to carry out this project; and that any premium received by the City upon the sale of any bonds or notes approved by this order, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds or notes, may be applied to the payment of costs approved by this order in accordance with Chapter 44, Section 20 of the General Laws, thereby reducing the amount authorized to be borrowed to pay such costs by a like amount.

The City of Taunton appropriate the amount of **\$1,668,000** in addition to the \$5,000,000 previously appropriated, for the purpose of paying costs for roof, window, and door repairs/replacements at the Joseph H Martin Middle School, 131 Caswell Street, East Taunton, MA 02718, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto (the "Project"), which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program, and for which the City of Taunton may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the City of Taunton's Building Committee. To meet this appropriation, the Treasurer Collector with the approval of the Mayor is authorized to borrow said amount under Chapter 44 of the General Laws or any other enabling authority. The City of Taunton acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs The City of Taunton incurs in excess of any grant that may be approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the City of Taunton; provided that the borrowing authorized pursuant to this order shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the City of Taunton and the MSBA; that the Mayor is authorized to take any other action necessary to carry out this project; and that any premium received by the City upon the sale of any bonds or notes approved by this order, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds or notes, may be applied to the payment of costs approved by this order in accordance with Chapter 44, Section 20 of the General Laws, thereby reducing the amount authorized to be borrowed to pay such costs by a like amount.

**RE: Request for Authorization of Municipal Charges Lien for Charges and Fees
Due to the Taunton Nursing Home Not Paid by the Due Date**

Dear Mayor Hoye and Members of the Municipal Council:

G.L. c.40, § 58 allows the City to impose a "municipal charges lien" on real property located within the City for any local charge or fee that has not been paid by the due date, provided that a separate vote by a city council is taken for each type of charge or fee.


The Taunton Nursing Home has recently reached out to the Law Department in an effort to reduce its accounts receivable. While it may not be effective in every case, I do believe that one additional tool that may assist the Nursing Home in collecting outstanding charges is the ability to impose municipal charges liens.

Therefore, I respectfully request that the Municipal Council take the following vote:

Pursuant to Section 58 of Chapter 40 of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Municipal Council hereby votes to authorize and approve the imposition of municipal charges liens for any and all charges, fees, and other funds lawfully due to the Taunton Nursing Home that have not been paid by the due date thereof, whether said charges and fees were incurred or due before or after the date of this vote.
