



Dear Mayor Hoye & Municipal Council Members:

At the regular scheduled meeting held on Thursday, September 15, 2016 the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on the proposal for a mixed use development in the Central Business District on property at 66 Main Street, submitted by Combined Realty LLC. The proposal was for 8 residential units on the 2nd & 3rd floors with the existing commercial use on the first floor. The Zoning Board of Appeals voted to deny their request.

During the hearing the Zoning Board of Appeals received a petition signed by abutters in the downtown area supporting the mixed use development proposal at 66 Main Street with the stipulation that the existing commercial use on the first floor, the Methadone Clinic, be closed and moved outside of the downtown area. (see attached petition)

The abutters requested that the Zoning Board of Appeals refer this to the Municipal Council and the Board of Health regarding their concerns with

the existing commercial use at 66 Main Street. The Board heard testimony from abutters relative to occupants lined up in the morning, trash and alleged illegal activity that occurs in the vicinity of the methadone clinic.

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The Zoning Board of Appeals informed the downtown businesses that they would be forwarding their concerns to the Municipal Council as you are the granting authority of Zoning Changes which allows certain uses downtown.
