
**RE:** Potential Special Election for the Casino Saturday, June 9, 2012

If the Special Election is held on Saturday, June 9, 2012, the following things must occur:

1. The last day to register to vote would be Friday, May 18, 2012
2. I would have to notify the polling locations:
  - ASAP for the private polling locations
  - Schools would have to be notified no later than April
3. The absolute last day to order ballots would be Friday, April 27, 2012
4. I would need to begin sending out absentee ballots on May 7, 2012 and have absentee ballots available in my office for any of our registered voters who would like to vote in the City Clerk's Office.
