**Airport Master Plan Update [AMPU] FY 2013 AIP Project [Replaces Phase 2 Land/Easement Project]:** Airport Solutions Group {ASG} recently conducted the project scoping meeting for the AMPU. Per FAA request, the AMPU scope will include detailed analysis for modification of two design standards associated with the EA/EIR project. ASG has previously submitted the draft scope of work and now the final scope of work for the AMPU.

**EA/EIR FY 2012 AIP Project Update:** ASG met with FAA and MassDOT Aeronautics on June 11, 2013 to discuss new East Side alternative that has less than the 5,000 sf of wetland impact. Action items were generated at the meeting that indicate a positive view of the alternative.

**Phase 1 RW 4-22 Easement/Land Acquisition – FY 2012 AIP Project [Cancelled; To Be Closed Out]:** A recent meeting with the FAA and MassDOT on June 11, 2013 confirmed action to close out The Phase 1 Land Easement and Land Acquisition Project associated with the reconstruction of Runway 4-22.

**Fuel Discount Program:** At the June meeting of the Airport Commission it was again voted to continue with the Fuel Discount Program. In brief, here is how the program works for users of the airport. The posted price of avgas is discounted 3% for all those who pay cash at point of sale. In addition, a progressive volume discount is offered to customers who use 100 or more gallons during any monthly billing cycle providing that their account is paid in full prior to the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the following month. 100 to 500 gallons = 3% discount, 500-1000 gallons = 5% discount, 1000-1500 gallons = 7% and over 1500 gallons = 10% discount.

**Taunton Municipal Airport Commission Meetings:** The TMAC meets at 7:00 p.m. on the last Wednesday of every month in the Leonard F. Rose SRE building unless otherwise noted. The next scheduled meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 31, 2013. The meetings are open to the public and all are invited to attend and participate.
