RE: Special Election, Saturday, June 9, 2012

Beginning on May 7, 2012, absentee ballots will be available for the special election. Residents may vote in person in the City Clerk's Office or may request to have a ballot sent via mail.

The last day and hour ^{RMB} ~~to register~~ to vote in the City Clerk's Office is June 8, 2012 at 12:00 PM. The only exception would be if a voter has entered a health care facility anytime after twelve o'clock noon of the 5th day before the relevant election. If this occurs, they can contact the City Clerk about the proper procedures to be followed.

All absentee ballots must be received in the City Clerk's Office by 8:00 PM on June 9, 2012.

The City Clerk's Office does advertise the polling locations in the Taunton Daily Gazette the Sunday prior to each election. The advertisement for this election of polling locations will be placed in the Sunday, June 3, 2012 edition of the Taunton Daily Gazette.
