Welcome to Summer Festival 2016! See permission slips for Friday's trip to Canobie Lake Park, Salem, NH. Please return the permission slip no later than Wednesday morning to the counselor assigned to your child's group. Permission slips are obtained at Summer Festival.



Summer Festival Wristbands need to be worn everyday at Summer Festival!

Any parent wishing to come on the trip as a chaperone is welcome to join us. Please remember that anyone accompanying us on the trip must have an approved C.O.R.I. form on file in the office. Please inform your child's counselor and payment (\$30.00) must be made by check or money order payable to the City of Taunton to the Office no later than Wednesday at 12:00 noon to confirm your reservation. This allows us to do a final count for buses.

1:00 PM All children will be going to **Hopewell Pool to swim.** Anyone wishing to swim in the deep end of the pool will be tested by the pool director. Anyone not meeting the requirements will only be allowed in the wading pool.
Pool Depth: Wading Pool- 12 inches to 30 inches
Swimming Pool- 4 feet to 8 feet
Please send your child with a bathing suit, towel, & sunscreen with his/her name marked on each item.
Sorry, no floatation devices are allowed in either pool.


